Description: This site is a timber and brush-covered location that has changed only by natural growth since 1910. Halm Creek, an ephemeral stream on a steep slope, runs into Saint Joe River just downstream from this site in a large flat. Occasional 1910 fire snags survive there, but that area is mostly revegetated.
