

# Lewis and Clark Field Trip

Location: Weippe Prairie, Lolo Campground, and Heart of the Monster in Kamiah

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**Objectives:** Students will be able to identify plant specimens and take journal notes of Lewis and Clark and Nez Perce traditions and locations.

**Materials:** Journals of Lewis and Clark, List of plants identified by Corps of Discovery, sack lunches, jackets, plant press.

**Background and pre-trip work:** Send in bus application. Classroom readings, activities and films to prepare for trip.

**Activity:** After field trip put a group of 20 different flowers arranged on a table. Students will work in groups of two to identify species. Students will use a variety of resources to assist them.

**Evaluation:** Students will mount and identify slides.
