This canal originates on the north bank of the Boise River in Section 17, T4N, R1W and extends northwesterly. The Dahlberg Canal was built in 1864. At that time, 150 inches of water under a four-inch pressure was appropriated and diverted. In 1906, the canal received water right (31) of 130 inches.
