AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 8571 OF THE COMPILED STATUTES OF IDAHO DEFINING THE INJURING OF MONUMENTS AND IMPROVEMENTS AS A MISDEMEANOR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Section 8571 of the Compiled Statutes of the State of Idaho be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 8571. Every person, not the owner thereof, who wilfully * * * mars, disfigures, breaks or otherwise injures, or molests, removes or destroys, any work of art, monument, landmark, historic structure, shade tree, shrub, ornamental plant, or useful or ornamental improvement, is guilty of a misdemeanor.

Sec. 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this Act shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage and approval.
