Pioneer Day was a legal holiday in Idaho from June 15, 1912, to June 15, 1942. Established by the legislature in 1911 following the 1910 celebration of fifty years of white settlement in Idaho, Pioneer Day was dropped by the 1943 session in a wartime revision that reduced the number of legal holidays set by law.
