The following is a list of battles, actions, combats, skirmishes, military events, etc., in Idaho from April 19, 1775 to July 1, 1902 as recorded by Francis B. Heitman in <u>Historical</u> <u>Register and Dictionary of the United States Army, from its Organization, September 29, 1789 to</u> <u>March 2, 1903</u>.

The campaign against the Blackfeet Indians in 1823 was not in Idaho.
