Condition: Good (for snags)

Description: Cedar Snags, North Fork, Saint Joe, near Bullion Creek. A great deal of salvage logging was undertaken after 1910, but in some areas, large snags from that fire have survived unaltered for three-quarters of a century. This grove occupies a swampy area and stands as significant evidence of a vast forest that was destroyed by intense heat.
