

FIELD TRIP CONFIRMATION Education Groups

IMPORTANT:

- Check your confirmation email to ensure your tour date and time are accurate.
- Allow at least 1 hour for your program. If your group arrives more than ten minutes late for a guided tour, guides may no longer be available.
- Dress for an outdoor experience and wear comfortable, practical walking shoes.
- Visitors should not attend if they are sick or exhibiting any cold or flu-like symptoms.

Dear Old Idaho Penitentiary Field Trip Organizer,

Your signature at the bottom of this page acknowledges that you have read, understood, and shared these instructions with all teachers, students, and chaperones.

- 1. The Old Idaho Penitentiary is a museum. Please be respectful and follow all site rules: No food, gum, candy or drinks (water is okay), no backpacks, no running or climbing, no pets are permitted on site.
- 2. Do not enter the site if you are sick.
- 3. We recommend scheduling at least 1 hour for Old Idaho Penitentiary tour programs (guided or self-guided)
- 4. You will have at least one teacher/chaperone per eight students (1:8). Your group cannot exceed more than one teacher/chaperone per four students (1:4). Having too few or too many chaperones is not appropriate for our programs.
- 5. Chaperones and teachers are there to assist with students. They must arrive with the group; those who arrive later will not be admitted. Everyone will stay with the group at all times. Bringing infants or toddlers or younger children is not appropriate.
- 6. Payment You can pay by check, cash or credit card (Visa or Mastercard). Entire payment, including your chaperones' admission, must be collected at the time of your visit.
- 7. You must provide us with the final number of students and chaperones no less than one week in advance of your field trip. Please see the "Group Number to Guide Key" on previous page.
- 8. Guided tours are only available for fourth grade or higher. Old Idaho Penitentiary guided tours are not always age appropriate for those younger than age 10.
- 9. Buses must park in the gravel parking lot at the base of the Foothills Trail Head. Buses that come to the upper parking lot will not be permitted to de-bus students, unless special arrangements have been made in advance.

Very important! Bus Parking:

Please do not bring buses up to the entrance area.

Follow signs and turn left before the Idaho Botanical Garden (in front of the two flag poles) to the bus parking area behind the Bishops' House. For safety reasons, buses proceeding up to the entrance will not be allowed to unload and will be directed back to the bus parking area. This may cause your class to lose time for their planned program.
