As we transition from planning our argument into creating the ACTUAL labels for your history fair project, you might wonder how we write those labels. The MA'AM template simplifies the writing process. See the table below. It will walk you through how to structure your labels as you finalize the writing for your project. Your final project should have between 10-12 labels.

		Write your sentence(s) here:
M	My Words: This sentence states your claim and advances your argument.	
A	Author's Words: Cite one specific piece of evidence from your research to prove your claim.	
A	Author's Words: Cite another specific piece of evidence from your research to prove your claim.	
M	My Words: Your conclusion sentence will explain the evidence supports your claim.
