- ✓ Watch the stories of Idaho’s five tribes in **Origins**.
- ✓ Experience the Big Burn in **North Idaho**.
- ✓ Watch Lonesome Larry’s journey in **Central Idaho**.
- ✓ See Geronimo’s drop in **South Idaho**.
- ✓ Look at the artifacts in the **Syringa Gallery**.

LISTEN

- ✓ Hear the sounds of nature on the Projection wall in **Origins**.
- ✓ Listen to the history of Sun Valley in **Central Idaho**.
- ✓ Play the music of Gene Harris in the **Stories Gallery**.
