In an effort to ensure our student competitors have a fair and fun experience National History Day in Idaho has enacted the following policies. Please take a few moments and read over them. We thank you in advance for adhering to these policies.

- 1. TURN OFF ALL CELL PHONES while viewing **any** student projects.
- 2. Refrain from cheering during documentaries and performances. Brief applause at the end is acceptable.
- 3. While walking/waiting in the hallways to view student projects keep your voices down so as not to disturb the judging process.
- 4. Please do not speak to the judges concerning the judging of your student's project; contact contest officials with any concerns.
- 5. While judging is in progress, stay in your seats and do not interject with your opinions.
- 6. Do not enter a room while judging is in progress.
- 7. Please do not eat in the judging rooms or hallways.
- 8. Judges have <u>absolute</u> authority to remove disruptive individuals from the judging room if they deem it necessary to protect the integrity of the judging process.
