### Contest Registration:

- **Students must register by March 1st.** No late registrations will be accepted. NO EXCEPTIONS!
  - \* Teachers and students can access the contest registration system at <https://id-tvr.nhd.org/>
  - \* Registration instructions can be accessed at <https://history.idaho.gov/wp-content/uploads/TV-Regional-Contest-Registration-Instructions.pdf>
  - \* The contest fee is \$10 and can be paid online or by check. See the contest registration instructions for details.
  - \* Websites and exhibits will be competing on March 13th and Performance, Documentary and Paper will compete on March 14th.
  
- **Websites:** you will need to provide the Weebly URL for your website during registration.
  - \* Your URL should look like this: <https://12345678.nhd.weebly.com>. If your URL has words instead of numbers in the middle, you'll need to convert it to NHD Weebly before you register.
  - \* To convert: go to [nhd.weebly.com](https://nhd.weebly.com) and login using your Weebly username and password. Click "Convert" and write down your new URL.
  - \* If you experience issues converting your website contact [nhdsupport@weebly.com](mailto:nhdsupport@weebly.com). When you register, you will type in the 8-digit number from your URL. You will be able to edit your website until the close of registration.
  - \* Once registration closes, your website will be automatically "lock" for judging so you will not be able to access your website until the day after your Regional Competition is complete. Please ensure that you have completed all edits before the close of registration.
  
- **Papers** will need to be uploaded in PDF format to your registration portal by the end of the registration period in order for your registration to be considered complete. Make sure your annotated bibliography is included.

### Entry Information:

- 1. Exhibits:** Competing March 13th
  - a. Exhibit set-up: 3:30-4:30pm
  - b. Exhibit hall will be closed to parents and spectators during judging.
  - c. Bring 3 copies of process paper and annotated bibliography
  - d. Arrive 30 min. prior to interview time
  - e. Dress professionally
- 2. Websites:** Competing March 13th
  - a. Technology: be prepared to display website on the computers and projectors available on campus
  - b. Arrive 30 min. prior to interview time
  - c. Dress professionally
- 3. Documentaries:** Competing March 14th

- a. Technology: be prepared to show documentary on the computers and projectors available. Have multiple ways to show your documentary (flash drive, publish to You Tube, cloud storage, etc.)
  - b. Bring 3 copies of process paper and annotated bibliography
  - c. Arrive 30 min. prior to interview time
  - d. Dress professionally
4. **Papers:** Competing March 14th
- a. Make sure paper has been uploaded to registration portal by March 6th.
  - b. Bring 3 hard copies of paper including annotated bibliography
  - c. Arrive 30 min. prior to interview time
  - d. Dress professionally
5. **Performances:** Competing March 14th
- a. Time Available: 5 min set up, 10 minutes performance, 5 min take down
  - b. No assistance by parents or teachers permitted
  - c. Bring 3 copies of process paper and annotated bibliography
  - d. Arrive 30 min. prior to interview time in costume

### FAQs:

1. *Do I have to stay at the school all evening or come both days?*

No- you only need to be at your judging interview, but you are welcome to support your friends and classmates and see other students' work.

2. *Do I have to be at the awards ceremony in order to receive my award?*

No- your teacher can pick up your award for you during or after the award ceremony. Any awards that have not been claimed will be mailed to the students' address.

3. *How can I find out who won?*

Results will be posted online at [www.history.idaho.gov/nhdi/contests](http://www.history.idaho.gov/nhdi/contests) and emailed to teachers the next week.

4. *Where should I hang out when I am not being judged?*

Students and families are welcome to hang out in the library or the lobby of the gym where the exhibits are being displayed.
